### **REFLECTION FOR ADVENT - The Season of Advent: Anticipation and Hope**

Advent is the beginning of the Church Year. The word Advent is from the Latin *adventus* for "coming" or arrival and marks the four weeks of preparation for Christmas. The focus of the season of Advent is the celebration of the birth of Jesus the Christ in his First Advent, and the anticipation of the return of Christ the King in his Second Advent. Advent is marked by a spirit of expectation, an anticipation and of preparation.

### **CHRISTMAS REFLECTION**

Christmas is the time we think of the birth of baby Jesus born in a manger, with Mary and Joseph beside him. The first witnesses of Christ's birth were the shepherds who were considered poor and lowly but were chosen. The angels announced in glory the birth of the savior for the first time to the shepherds. God chose the shepherds and not the kings and powerful or rich people.

Christmas is not just a day to remember and commemorate, it is not just a season to celebrate ... Christmas is love. It is the time when the love of God is revealed to us and received by all people of goodwill, not only to the shepherds and the "magi" to whom the Lord has chosen to reveal, but also to us today.
