Constructing pictograms and other charts.

Religious Education

To know important stories from the New Testament. To learn more about the Rosary. To understand and take part in stillness and prayer. To learn more about Saint Francis of Assisi and St. Chad. To learn about the feats of All Saints. To begin to understand prayer as communication with God.

Science

Physical Education
